1 ... not to be discriminated.



2 ... to live healthy, to find security and not to suffer from distress.



3 ... to live with their parents and being cared by them.



4 ... to get an education meeting their needs and abilities.



5 ... to play, to relax and to take part in cultural and artistic activities.



6 ... to have access to information, to build up their own mind and to have a say.



7 ... to be protected from violence, abuse and exploitation.



8 ... to have privacy and to be respected in their dignity.



9 ... to be protected during a war and on the run.



10 ... to be supported and protected if they are disabled, so that they can play an active role in the community.

Children should know their rights and respect rights of others. Thus we can all live together in peace - in Germany and around the globe. The children's rights are valid up to the age of 18 and are written down in the "Convention on the Rights of the Child". This resolution has 54 articles in total and was adopted by the United Nations on 20 November 1989.
